Dear Parent/Guardian

We have decided to dismiss the Year 12s on Friday afternoon. Since our return to school, teachers have been working hard with your child to complete the assessments required to allow them to decide on a centre determined grade for each of their students. This has been a difficult process for all and I pay tribute to your child for their positive response to the significant challenges presented to them.

The work has now been completed in the majority of subjects. The exceptions are GCSE Art, GCSE Construction, GCSE History, OS Bench Joinery. Students who study these subjects will be expected to attend school on the days and times below.

Monday 17 May	GCSE Construction
Tuesday 18 May	GCSE Construction and GCSE History
Wednesday 19 May	GCSE Art and OS Bench Joinery
Thursday 20 May	GCSE Art and OS Bench Joinery

The next stage in the awarding process does not involve your child. It is teacher led and involves marking, internal standardisation and moderation. This work will be undertaken internally and will be completed on Thursday 20 and Friday 21 May, two Qualification Procedure Days, awarded to schools by the Department of Education. Please be assured that the grading procedure will be carried out professionally and with integrity and fairness.

Final GCSE grades will be submitted to CCEA on 4 June 2021. GCSE grades will be issued to students on Thursday 12 August 2021. Unfortunately, at this point we can not be sure what arrangements will be put in place for the distribution of results but we will clarify this closer to the time.

## Transition Plans

We are acutely aware that this is a key point of transition for our Year 12s and that you and they are making plans for their future after St Benedict's. Some will transfer to another post primary school or regional college to continue their education, while others will move in to an apprenticeship or employment.

Mrs Devlin, our Head of CEIAG, has been in touch with local schools and education establishments that might be of interest to your child and she has produced the table on the next page which outlines how your child can apply to these institutions. We recognise that some students have already made application to NRC, Belfast Met and CAFRE and they can still do so but now is the time to make applications to local schools. We would encourage you to actively support your child in contacting the schools they are interested in and in making applications to them asap. ### End of term arrangements
